Regenie,

While I was unable to attend today's conference call regarding Canto's response to the crisis in Haiti - I did want to forward you information on how WireIE can potentially help Canto in this area.

Once Canto has completed its initial assessment of needs, in the mid term WireIE would be able to:

- Implement a portable wimax/wifi network that is self contained
- build a transportable source of electric power for the Wimax network and satellite earth station, if available - via renewable energy (solar or wind)

Also, for future planning WireIE could build, store in containers in Barbados, and train local residents on implementation and use for future crisis (earthquake, hurricane...).

Please advise us on the outcome of your conference call today and also keep in mind that WireIE - along with some of our Canadian partners (Telus, Sasktel International, HP and CTDI) would be more than happy to help solve the challenges that Haiti is currently facing in the short and long term.
