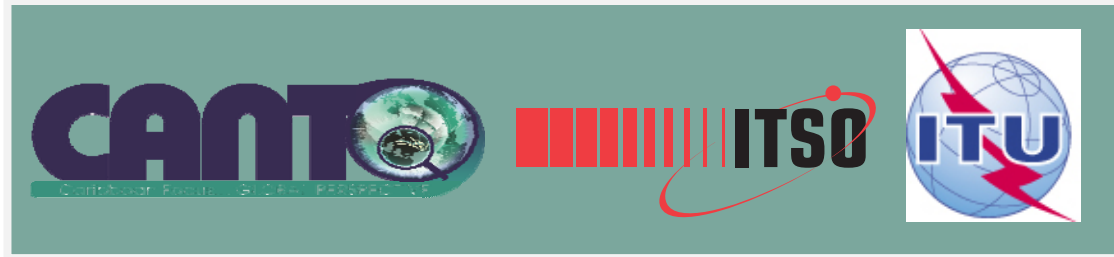


SATELLITE COMMUNICATION WORKSHOP
