




Key Indicators for the Internet Market (2016)





Net Neutrality – Guiding Principles



Net Neutrality Recommendations

- 1. No blocking and throttling or intentionally restricting of lawful content, services and applications
- 2. Relaxed our position on paid prioritisation and zero-rated pricing (cases evaluated on merit with punishment of actual harmful and proven offences)



OTT Recommendations

- 1. CLASSIFICATION 1: Functionally Equivalent OTT Services a case for regulation can be made we may need some amendments to the legislative framework to ensure efficient sector regulation
- 2. CLASSIFICATION 2: Other OTT Services
 Regulation may take other forms specifically in areas of cyber security, data protection, child pornography, intellectual property rights, national security and privacy and other public interest matters.

And That Android Box Issue...


- The Android Box itself is not illegal

Operators perspective


- Concession Condition D 13
